

These instructions are for users running Microsoft Windows XP, and have Internet Explorer 6, or later.

These instructions will guide you thru the download and install process of the QuickTime application that runs under Windows XP. QuickTime allows you to play any video file whose name ends with the characters: **.mov**

.mov means the file is a movie with sound.

While each movie has an accompanying sound track, audio in your computer is not required. You can still see the movie, you just can't hear it.

1. Make at least 99 megabytes of hard disk storage available on your computer.
2. If possible, set your display screen size to 1024 x 768 pixels, or better.
3. Stop all applications currently running on your computer.
4. Launch Microsoft Internet Explorer (Version 6.)
5. This download and install does not require that you have an Apple computer.
6. Enter the following characters exactly as shown, on the Internet Explorer line labelled 'address'.

- (Do not enter the above characters in the box to the right of the Search Web button.)
7. Click the "Go" button on the right.
8. You should see a large window with "QuickTime7 for windows" displayed.
9. Click the button labelled "Free Download". Do not click the "Upgrade Now" button unless you want to pay for a fancier version of QuickTime. These directions are based on you not clicking the Upgrade.
10. A new window appears that has a pane on the left that contains 2 (round) radio buttons, 3 checkboxes, a place for you to enter your email address, and a button labelled "Free Download Now".
11. Select the round radio button that does **not** offer **iTunes** (unless you want to download additional and special audio software in addition to what you already have. Your current sound system is all you need.) Uncheck all 3 checkboxes. Doing this will allow you to proceed without supplying your email address in the box so labeled. These directions are based on the assumption that you uncheck all 3 checkboxes.
12. Click the "Free Download Now" button.
13. A window will appear that shows the progress of the download to your computer. This downloads an 18 MB install program (QuickTimeInstaller) that you will use to install QuickTime.
14. You will also be asked to either Run or Save the above install program. You can do either, but I suggest clicking Save. If you chose Save, select a place on your hard drive to save this and write down the hard drive location for later use. By clicking Save, you save the install program. If something should go wrong in the install process, you simple double click the install program wherever you saved it. You don't have to download it again.
15. Please be patient while the download proceeds, especially if your computer's download speed is slow. Do not click the mouse or touch the keyboard while the download is in progress.

16. When the download is complete, you will see a Congratulations window. Regardless of what the window says, you have not yet installed QuickTime; you have only downloaded the install program.
17. Make the Congratulations window go away (click the red X in the uppermost right corner of your screen.)
18. If you have a desktop icon or some means of going directly to your Windows Explorer, follow the procedure below named **Direct**. If you do not have a direct means of going to the Windows Explorer, follow the procedure below named **InDirect**.
19. **Direct**.
 1. Click or otherwise bring up Windows Explorer.
Continue below, under the **InDirect** block.
20. **InDirect**.
 1. Click the Start button on the Status bar at the bottom left of your screen.
 2. Select All Programs.
 3. Move your cursor onto Accessories.
 4. Move your cursor in the popup window that appears, to the Windows Explorer line and click.
21. In Windows Explorer navigate to the place on your hard drive where you saved the QuickTimeInstaller file. It is named QuickTimeInstaller.exe. Double click it. If you have forgotten where you saved it, use the Search function in Windows Explorer and click on the "Date Modified" header to see files in date order.
22. If a window(s) appears asking for your permission to proceed (probably from your security system), respond as necessary to proceed.
23. Follow the prompts:
 1. Click Yes, to the license agreement.
 2. Leave "checked", the "Install Apple Software Update to easily..." which will alert you when future releases of QuickTime become available.
24. When the "Quick Time Installer Completed" window appears, click the Finish button. You can explore the other buttons on the page, optionally later.
25. Click the **NoThanks** button to exit without upgrading to the Pro version (not free).
26. From now on, whenever you see or there is a file in your computer that ends with **.mov** you can simply double click on that file and see and hear the movie underneath.
